<b>NMS Plan</b>	5/29/2008	<a href="#">Release No. 34-57848</a>	The options exchanges and the OCC have filed a plan to develop and implement procedures designed to facilitate the listing and trading of standardized options.
<b>SEC</b>	5/28/2008	<a href="#">Release No. 34-57877</a>	The SEC has reorganized its regional and district office structures.
<b>ISE</b>	5/21/2008	<a href="#">SR-ISE-2008-29</a>	The SEC has approved ISE's proposed rule change to allow members, during times when the ISE market is inferior to the NBBO, to enter orders into the Price Improvement Mechanism at a price that matches the national best bid or offer.

<b>FINRA</b>	5/27/2008	<a href="#">SR-FINRA-2008-023</a>	FINRA is proposing to expand its Minor Rule Violation Plan to include violations of options position and exercise limits and contrary exercise advice procedures.
<b>FINRA</b>	5/23/2008	<a href="#">SR-FINRA-2007-026</a>	FINRA is proposing to expand its TRACE data to show, for each disseminated transaction, that the transaction is either an inter-dealer transaction or a transaction where the customer and the member referenced are either a buyer or a seller.
<b>FINRA</b>	5/23/2008	<a href="#">SR-FINRA-2008-022</a>	FINRA is proposing to amend IM-1013-1 to state that NYSE members admitted to FINRA pursuant to IM-1013 will be subject to FINRA's By-Laws and Schedules to By-Laws, including Schedule A, the consolidated FINRA rules, and the Incorporated NYSE Rules, provided that the members' securities business is limited to the permitted floor activities.
<b>FINRA</b>	5/21/2008	<a href="#">SR-FINRA-2008-019</a>	FINRA is proposing to amend certain language used in Rule 2821 to modify the rule's scope and the timing of principal review. FINRA is also proposing to clarify various issues raised by commentators by producing a "Supplementary Material" section that would follow the rule text.

\* With regard to rule proposals of SROs, the date represented is the date of the SEC release seeking comment, except where the SEC has not yet published the rule for comment. In that case, the date represented is the date the SRO submitted the proposal to the SEC.
