# Coronavirus COVID-19 – Government Action – March 26, 2020

# CONGRESS

The US Senate passed <u>H.R. 748, the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act</u> (CARES) Act, its Phase III coronavirus response and economic stimulus bill on March 25 by a 96-0 vote. The House is scheduled to consider the legislation on Friday, March 27. The CARES Act contains approximately \$2 trillion in overall spending, including over \$300 million in emergency supplemental appropriations. The bill provides for direct loans and grants for small and medium-sized businesses and industries that have experienced significant financial losses due to the unprecedented public health crisis; \$100 billion to hospitals and healthcare providers for COVID-19 related expenses and lost revenue; and direct cash payments for many Americans. It also makes many changes to labor, employee benefits, and tax policy.
