Law360's Glass Ceiling Report, which surveys law firms on the demographics of their U.S. lawyer workforce, shows that women represent about a quarter of partners and 21.5% of equity partners.

Last year, we talked to women who have made it to the highest levels of their firms. Among other things, they recalled the difficulty of managing a partnership track and child care.
